LEARNING

I just started reading the book of Ezekiel this morning! This book was one of my favorite ones to study in bible school, not because it makes sense haha, but because you see God's character and you see Ezekiel's obedience to what God calls him to do. In the first few chapters you can already see God's holiness, his love, his power and his grace! God calls Ezekiel to a hard ministry, he wants him to deliver messages to Israel that they don't want to hear. But God doesn't send him by himself to do it in his own strength! God gives encouragement and assurance: "The hand of the Lord was upon him"(1:3); "The spirit entered into me."(2:2); "the hand of the Lord was upon me"(3:22) "God would do through Ezekiel what he had called Ezekiel to do. We live and minister in a way that is pleasing to the Lord only by the power of his grace."(Paul David Tripp) We don't have what it takes but God does!
