Dear Friends,

Habakkuk 3:17-18 (NASB) says: *“Though the fig tree should not blossom, and there be no fruit on the vines, though the yield of the olive should fail, and the fields produce no food, though the flock should be cut off from the field, and there be no cattle in the stalls, yet I will exult in the LORD, I will rejoice in the God of my salvation”*. I shared these verses for the FIEIDE annual Assembly devotional time on Fri. April 24th. Santiago (the other elder with me) is now preaching one Sunday a month. We're in a 12-week series on the epistle of *James*. **The church retreat on Apr. 10-12th**, with the *Walk thru the Bible* seminar (the whole Bible taught by Jordi), went very well. Some could only come on Saturday, so we had 30 people at those sessions. On Friday night and Sunday sessions, we were 24 people. Everyone enjoyed the times of learning, and times of fellowship at mealtimes or free times (see the photos).

Other ministry. On Apr. 23-26th **Salud and I** attended the *Annual FIEIDE National Assembly-Congress* near Valencia (8 hrs. drive), about 50 churches sent delegates. **Salud** helped at the Ladies Dept. stand and promoted the Nov. retreat in *Andalucía* too. **I** gave the only devotional for the Assembly, with 150 people that morning. On Mar. 14th, **Salud** presided a FIEIDE Andalucía Ladies conference at a church 40-mi. away. Nine women from the Puebla church went, & there were almost 60 women in all. **The Messianic Prophecy conference** I gave at a nearby Baptist church for Palm Sunday went really well, with over 100 people attending that day. At the Seville Theological Seminary, **I'm** finishing a history class on the Second Reformation of Spanish Protestantism (in the 19th and 20th centuries). **Please pray for our service in these different ministries, as we combine them with serving in the Puebla Church too, that the Lord would help us to be useful in building up all the believers for a stronger commitment/walk with Christ!**
