LEARNING

God continues to teach and convict me so much as I seek to grow and learn in ministry. I've made it to the minor prophets! On this adventure through God's word that I started almost a year ago (when I arrived in Utah) I have been so impacted by how God speaks through His word to me. Two verses have really been on my mind this month though. The first one is Daniel 1:8a " But Daniel resolved that he would not defile himself with the King's food, or with the wine that he drank." This verse is challenging to me... have I resolved to not defile myself with the world? With sin? Do I have a line that I will not cross? Have I resolved to live my daily life holy, set apart for the Lord, for His ministry?
