I pray all is going well with each of you. Two months have passed since my last update. And the question many of you have is “How are the house plans coming along?” Well, all the plans are finished. We are just waiting on the architect to put it



all together for us. We are nearing a full year on doing the plans. That is actually a long time, even by Peruvian standards. That being said, I really think God was behind this as we have been pretty busy helping with Angela's grandpa (see previous updates).

Max hasn't been coming to the Saturday Bible study. Anderson seems disinterested. Gabriel told his mom that he's been coming to the Bible study but we haven't seen him in 3 weeks. Angeles has secret communications with a boy from her school. These are only a few of the struggles that the kids are having. As far as the adults go, the only regular ones (around 6-7) that come are all saved except Adela. Please pray for her salvation.

Angela has stopped the Bible study she was doing until the other responsibilities die back down. I am continuing the Bible interpretation class with the leaders of the Ciudad Blanca church. I have one more lesson and then I think I'll shift gears towards some basic doctrines. They've been taught these doctrines but they lack the ability to show why they believe them to be true. Hopefully this class can be a help.

Angela just told me to add this message from her. I, Angela, want to be a blessing to my family in the midst of these times of stress and change, whether it's in regards to my grandpa (stroke), my dad (beginning stages of dementia), my mom (bitterness towards my dad), or any number of other issues. I really just want to show them Christ through my actions and attitudes but I find that many times I fail. But God is teaching me that showing Christ in the midst of these times is a privilege. *Phillipians 4:6-7 Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.*
