Marcos was able to host the very first church service in Alto Shambuyaku.



19 people came to the first service. There was a kids program happening at the same time, so it was 15 moms and 3 men from the community that came.



We hosted the second church service on June 27th. This one was also primarily moms and their children. Marcos taught on the feeding of the 5,000.



Allyson started a group for the moms at CBT. They had their first meeting on Tuesday and there were 7 families that came!
